about your visit to see The Red Dress at ACEarts, Somerton.

1. **ARE WE SELLING TICKETS?...NO**, we are not selling tickets or charging an entrance fee – that's right it's free!
2. **CHARITY...** But we are a charity, and donations are always welcome – online, through the till or in our donation boxes. Your donations allow us to put on extraordinary exhibitions like The Red Dress and many other events.
3. **WE ARE EXPECTING LOTS OF PEOPLE...** We know a lot of people are looking forward to visiting The Red Dress so we will be busy. There may be a queue to get in the building, but it really will be worth the wait. And, of course, a queue is the perfect opportunity to meet new people, and discuss all the other wonderful independent shops, eateries, and historical buildings in glorious Somerton.
4. **ON THAT NOTE...** if you are hoping to eat out in town, as part of your trip to Somerton, it's worth booking a table at one of the wonderful food establishments in town - they are also expecting lots of people and many places are starting to fill up. There are also a couple of bakeries, a sandwich shop and take-aways - so you're spoilt for choice.
5. **ALSO ON THAT NOTE...** the car parks in Somerton are FREE but they are going to be busy, so be prepared. We highly recommend lift sharing and Somerton is on a bus route, too. There is a long stay car park – it is free, despite signs to the contrary. Please do park there and give yourself plenty of time to explore the town.
6. **ACCESS...**The Red Dress is upstairs in our exhibition space. We have a chair lift to the first floor and a wheelchair for use by you and your supporters during your visit. The ground floor of our building is easily accessible for those with limited mobility or wheelchairs. We have wide aisles throughout the ground floor and an accessible toilet. There is a level entrance to the building from the road. If you have any concerns about access, please call 01458 273008 and we will do our best to help.
7. **DOGS...**unfortunately, during The Red Dress exhibition, only Assistance Dogs will be allowing into the upstairs exhibition space.
